

**UPDATE TO RAPID ANTIGEN TESTING** UPDATED ON 9/15/2020

Previously, Rapid Antigen Tests were only considered a COVID-19 positive case if the person was symptomatic and had an epidemiological link.

The NJDOH (following CSTE industry guidelines) determined that **POSITIVE Rapid Antigen COVID-19 Tests are all Probable Cases** regardless of symptoms or contact.

These results (antigen) now need to be reported person to person to the Communicable Disease Department for investigation.
